Dear Parent,

You have indicated that your child \_\_\_\_\_ has a potentially severe food allergy that may require treatment at school. Dumas ISD requires additional information in order to take necessary precautions for your child's safety and to authorize treatment of your child in the event of an allergic reaction at school or at a school-related activity. Please have your child's doctor fill these out and return them to the school as soon as possible.

- **Food Allergy Action Plan (FAAP)/Emergency Action Plan (EAP)**  
This should be on file for every student with a severe allergy. Must be updated and signed by the doctor every school year. This form provides information about the child's food allergy, outlines the care the child will need in managing the food allergy, and outlines actions to be taken in case of an allergic reaction.
- **Request for the Administration of Medication form.**  
This must be filled out and signed by the parent AND the physician. *Make sure the physician notes if your child is to carry an emergency medication (epinephrine, inhaler, etc) with them - otherwise it is to be kept by the nurse.*
- **Statement Regarding Meal Substitutions or Modifications**  
This must be filled out and signed the physician.
- **Authorization to Secure Emergency Treatment/ Medical Information Sheet**  
Must be filled out and signed by parent/guardian

Your Child's supplies should include: Epinephrine device with prescription label on it, and/or antihistamine (such as Benadryl) if your child's plan calls for them. *Please be alert to the expiration dates on these medications.* If we do not have the above forms and supplies on hand and your child has a serious reaction, we may need to call 911 to assure your child's safety. Unfortunately, this cost is billed to the parent.
