

**SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING**

The SHAC committee met for 45 minutes and viewed two videos presented by Paula Lewis. The first video, "Growing Up For Girls" will be used per committee decision in 5<sup>th</sup> grade. The committee asked Paula to find a more elementary video to show to 4<sup>th</sup> grade girls. The second video, "Growing Up For Boys" will be shown in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade this year. The male administrator will present the video to both groups to determine which age group is more receptive.

The committee compared this to what is currently shown and compared it to the Worth the Wait curriculum in 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> science and Health. The committee would like to see if pregnancy and STD rates have decreased since the induction of the Worth the Wait curriculum. Paula will check with the hospital to see if they have any numbers that can be used as a gage.

The committee was introduced to Jessica Sutterfield, Director of Special Services, who is the interim SHAC chair till the end of the school year since Mrs. Legg was promoted to Assistant Superintendent.
